




























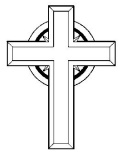

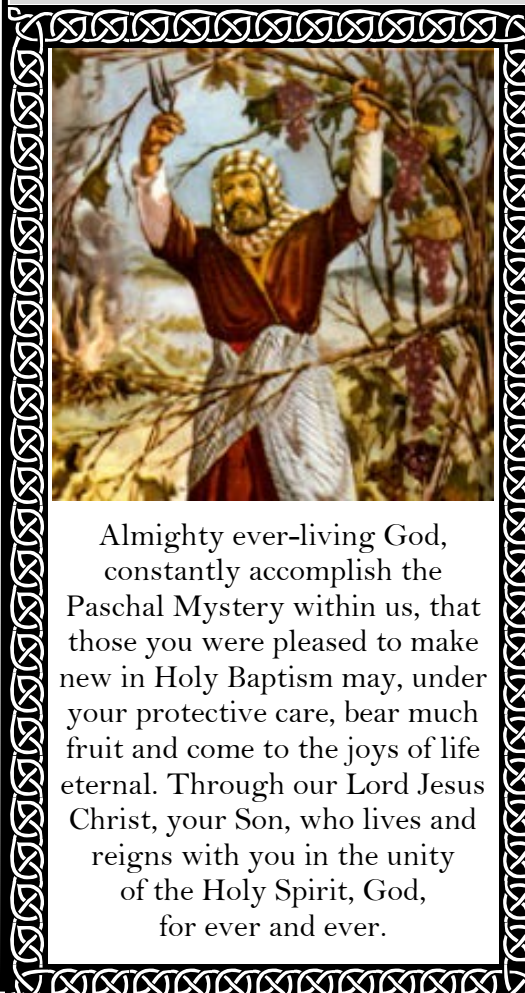

Widow's Coffee Cup

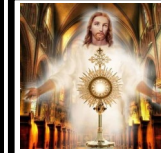
Just over two years ago we began this support group which meets every 1st Monday of the month from 10:00—11:00 a.m. Through this group we bring hope and healing to one another.

Dear Children of St. Cecilia's,

We wanted to tell you how your love and kindness continue to help us by your children's weekly offering.

You have graciously given \$3,500.00 in the last 5 years to help us have a better life.

Let me tell you about some of my friends: Tadele, 7, is autistic and lies on his bed most of the time. He does not speak and has a physical disability. Ruhama, 2, was abandoned by her mother who was abused and left because she feared her family's anger & shame. Eight month old, Paulos, was abandoned by his mother, who is currently under medical care after being abused in Saudi Arabia, where she was a migrant worker. Hilina, 12, has severe physical disabilities. She cannot speak and lies in bed all day. But the Sisters say her health is improving since she arrived at our home 2 years ago badly malnourished and underweight. (We don't know what happened to her).

We are learning to take care of ourselves here and we can feel the beauty of having a warm, caring family life. CNEWA gives us education, health care, and a secure home for those who have been abandoned.

CNEWA (Catholic Near East Welfare Assoc.) works in Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine, & Syria.
