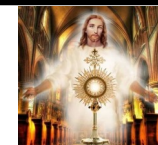
May is the month for St. Cecilia's Parish to host the local Food Pantry distribution day!

Why aren't the church bells ringing?

After 25 years, the electronic components for the bells have died. As with electronics these are not repairable but must be completely replaced. This is the same problem that our 30 year old elevator is having. We are scheduled to replace the electronics in the elevator in the late summer. The cost for this will be approximately \$80,000. Thanks to the Living the Faith

Campaign we are able to pay for this with an additional withdrawal from our savings.

We also have sufficient money to pay for the bell electronic replacement. The cost for this will be just over \$10,000. I am frequently asked by people if there is a memorial project to which they could make a donation. The bells would be one such project. If you would like to make a dedicated donation for the bells please contact Fr. Kevin.
